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### Summary Annual Report for SHEET METAL WORKERS LOCAL 265 PENSION FUND

This is a summary of the annual report for SHEET METAL WORKERS LOCAL 265 PENSION FUND, EIN 36-6168611, Plan Number 001, for the period July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008. The annual report has been filed with the Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

#### **Basic Financial Statement**

Benefits under the plan are provided by a trust and insurance contracts. Total plan expenses were \$8,321,036. These expenses included \$1,577,488 in administrative expenses and \$6,743,548 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries. A total of 3,118 persons were participants in or beneficiaries of the plan at the end of the plan year, although not all of these persons had yet earned the right to receive benefits.

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$217,935,971 as of June 30, 2008, compared to \$228,481,086 as of July 1, 2007. During the plan year the plan experienced a decrease in its net assets of \$10,545,115. This change includes unrealized appreciation or depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. The plan had total loss of \$2,224,079 which included employer contributions of \$12,413,457, losses of \$6,859,010 from the sale of assets and losses from investments of \$7,778,526.

#### **Minimum Funding Standards**

An actuary's statement shows that enough money was contributed to the plan to keep it funded in accordance with the minimum funding standards of ERISA.
